World Archery Asia Development Committee is organizing 2017 Joint Archery Training Program for the Asian archers. The Joint Training Program aims at enhancing the competition performance of Asian archers and developing the capacity for teaching and coaching of archery coaches as well.

- · Date: September 27~30, 2017 (4 days) (arrival: Sep. 26, departure: Oct. 1)
- · Venue: National Taiwan Sports University (NTSU), (Taipei, Chinese Taipei)
- · Program: 1 Archery Technical Training
  - 2 Archery Shooting Skills Training
  - (3) Archery Scientific Subject Presentation
  - (4) Archery Match Management & Test Match Tournament
  - **5** Archery Test and measurement
  - 6 Other related shooting skills practice & Training
- · Participants: Maximum 6 people for each MA
  - Both archers and coaches are eligible to participate, but more than half of participants must be archers per one MA to follow the main goal of this program.
- · Accommodation and meals: WAA will support accommodation and 3 meals (max. 6) for the participants,
