Anti-Doping Information – The 2023 Prohibited List

The World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) has published the 2023 Prohibited List (the List), which will become effective on 1 January 2023. Athletes and athlete support personnel are strongly advised to familiarize themselves with the List and its modifications.

The Hong Kong Anti-Doping Committee (HKADC) has recently produced a pocket-sized 2023 Prohibited List and an infographic highlighting some major modifications. Copies of the 2023 Prohibited List with the Summary of major modifications and explanatory notes, and the infographic are enclosed for your reference.

Please remind your athletes to bring along the latest Prohibited List and show it to physicians during their medical consultations. If any International-Level or National-Level athlete (as defined by the respective International Federations and HKADC respectively) needs to use any prohibited substance / prohibited method on the List to treat a medical condition, he / she must apply for a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) before use.

Please circulate the enclosed materials to the members and athletes of your Association for their information. The electronic version of the List, the infographic and details for the application of TUE are also available for download on HKADC website.
