FITA Constitution & Rules 2010

- 1) Set System
- 2) Compound Match Round
- 3) Mixed Team

WHY SET SYSTEM ???

- The winner of the match may not be the archer with the highest total score in the match.
- The winner of the match is decided by the number of points accumulated by each archer on the basis of sets won, tied or lost.
- ◆An archer gets 2 points for a won set.
- ◆An archer gets 1 point for a tied set.
- ◆An archer gets no points for a lost set.

Major Changes

Article 4.5.1.4.

- No of entry: Top 104 athletes will enter to the Elimination Round (mandatory for World Archery Championship)
- ➤ No of **SETS** shoot:
- •In the Elimination Round, athletes will shoot a series of matches in group, each match consisting of the best of 5 sets of 3 arrows OR the best of 3 sets of 6 arrows.
- The Final Round, each match consisting of the best of
 5 sets of 3 arrows culminating in the Gold Medal match

New Pairing Chart for WCH

- ◆ Top 104 archers qualify for match play.
- ◆ Top 8 archers in the ranking round advance without shooting in the 1/48 and 1/24 Rounds.

Scoring

Article 7.6.1.4.1. In each set an athlete can score a maximum of 60 (for 6 arrows) or 30 points (for 3 arrows). The athlete with the highest score of that end obtain 2 set points; in case of a tied score both athlete obtain 1 set point.

Article 7.6.1.4.2. As soon as an athlete reach 4 set points (4 of 6 possible) in a 3 set match or 6 set points (6 of 10 possible) in a 5 set match, he/she is declared winner and passes to the next round.

TIE-BREAK IN SET SCORES

Article 7.6.5.2.2.

1st bullet: A single arrow shoot-off for score

2nd bullet: If there is a tie the arrow closest to the centre

of the target face will resolve the tie



Adate to remember: 01 April 2011 Compound Match Round

Compound Match Round (effective 01 April 2011)

Article 4.5.1.5

- ◆The Elimination Round ...the top 104 athletes.... They shoot a series of matches in groups, each match consisting 4 sets of 3 arrows.
- ◆The Final Round, .. each match consisting 4 sets of 3 arrows culminating in the medal match with 6 sets of 3 arrows. The athletes will alternate shooting 1 arrow at a time.
- ◆ The Team Elimination Round, .. Top 16 team of 3 athletes ... shoot simultaneously ... each match consisting of 4 sets of 3 arrows (1 per athlete).
- ◆The Team Finals Round, consisting of 4 sets of 3 arrows (1 per athlete) culminating in the Medal matches with 6 sets of 3 arrows. The teams shoot alternately in 3 arrow segments. The timing is start and stopped when athlete crosses the 1m line

- ◆The Compound Elimination and Final Rounds are shot at 50M on hit/miss target face.

For Compound Division on a Qualification Round consisting of a 50M Compound Round followed by the Compound Match Round

▶4.5.1.6.

The 50M Compound Round consist of 72 arrows on the **80cm** target face

Ties in set point (Compound Match Round)

Article 7.6.5.2.4.. Individuals:

A single arrow (for team 1 per team member) shoot-off for score (maximum of 3 shoot-offs)

If still tie after 3 shoot-offs, highest ranked athlets (team) wins

MIXED TEAM


Articles 4.5.1.4. - 5th bullet and 4.5.1.5. - 5th bullet
The Mixed Team Round in which the top 16 teams
composed of the **top ranked man and the top ranked women** from the same Member Association are seeded
according to their positions as determined by their total
score in the Qualification Round, shoot simultaneously a
series of matches, **each match consisting of 4 ends/sets of 4 arrows (2 per athlete)**

FACE SET UP


The Compound Elimination and Final Rounds are shot at 50M on hit/miss target face

Article 7.2.1.4.

The target face will be 40cm square shape. The target face will have a circular hit zone of 10cm diameter in yellow with a non-scoring aiming zone of 30cm diameter in red on a light blue background with a 40xc40cm size. The tolerance of the scoring zone will not exceeds +/-1mm. The hit zone is scored as 1 and anything else is scored as M.



FACE SET UP Article 7.2.2.4.



1st Bullet

For the Elimination Round (no alternation shooting), 1 face will be placed horizontally on the left side of the centre (3 arrows to be shot by the left archer) and the right side of the centre (3 arrows to be shot by the right archer).

FACE SET UP

2nd Bullet


For the Finals (alternate shooting), 3 Hit/Miss target face will be placed horizontally on the target, 1 in the centre, 1 left and 1 right of it. The borders of the target face background touch

each other.

3rd Bullet


For The Team and Mixed Team Elimination Round, 1 Hit/Miss target face will be placed per athlete

NB: two or three faces set up



Face Set Up Article 7.4.2.4.

4th Bullet
For the Mixed Team
Finals, four Hit/Miss
target face will be
setup in 2 rows. 1 face
for each arrow.



What about INDOOR ???

Indoor Round

- >Set system apply
- Article 4.5.2.5. they shoot a series of matches in group, each match consisting the best of 5 sets of 3 arrows (See also articles 8.6.1.4.1, 8.6.1.4.2.)
- New score sheet for SET SYSTEM
- ➤ NO Compound Match Round NO new target face
- NO New Parting Chart 1/16 (32 athletes) paring chart STILL apply

OTHERS MAJOR CHANGES

➤ 80cm-6 ring and 80cm-5 ring target face Article 7.2.1.1.

3rd bullet: 80cm-6 ring face may be used at 50m, 40m and 30m (the triangular multiple set-up is mandatory for World Archery Championships at 50m) ...

4th bullet: 80cm-5 ring face may be used at the 30m distance (the triangular multiple set-up is mandatory for World Archery Championships) ...

> Article 7.2.2.2.

When using a triangular multiple-center face (5 or 6 ring) set up at 50/40/30m or the 4 centers face set up the **maximum distance** above the ground of the upper face(s) will be 172 cm and **the minimum distance** above the ground of the lower faces will be 90 cm.

>Article 7.5.6.1.

GREEN On the lights changing colour 10 seconds later

>Article 7.5.5.1.


20 seconds is the time allowed for an athlete to shoot 1 arrow (including tie-break) when shooting alternately in Olympic and Compound Match Round matches. (see also article 7.5.7.2.)

- >Article 7.5.5.4.
- **80 seconds** is allowed for a Mixed Team to shoot **4 arrows**, 2 per athlete
- >Article 7.5.5.2.
- **40 seconds** is the time allowed:

3rd bullet: for the Mixed Team to shoot their 2 arrows for the purpose of breaking ties

- > Article 7.5.5.3.
- 1 minute is allowed for a team to shoot 3 arrows, 1 per athlete in the Team Round for the purpose of breaking tie.
