Appendix II

Requirement for 9th ICECP's Applicant from September 2016 to April 2017

Each Association might nominate <u>one</u> qualified coach to the Federation for the above Programme on condition that the candidate fulfills the following conditions:-

I. Admission requirement

- (a) Nomination letter by the respective Association from the President/ Chairman/ Hon. Secretary General of the Association;
- (b) Proof in Level 3 or above in English Languages in Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education Examine or Grade C or above in English Language (Syllabus B) in Hong Kong Certificate of Education Examination or equivalent with documentary proof on the education qualification;
- (c) To belong a federation of a sport on the Olympic programme;
- (d) To hold the rank of official national coach recognized in Hong Kong and/or by the respective International Federation;
- (e) To be active and able to prove that he/she has practical experience as a coach at national / international level, and
- (f) To be fluent in reading, writing and speaking in English.

II. Paper Submission

After the completion of the Programme, the participant is required to provide the Federation the following documents for the onwards submission to the Olympic Solidarity soonest possible or by the latest within two weeks from each module:

- (a) a final report from the training centre containing a general assessment of the scholarship holder and the qualifications obtained in the final examinations (diploma or certificate);
- (b) a report form the scholarship holder via respective National Olympic Committee (NOC) giving the experience of the completed training programme; and
- (c) information regarding the position held by the coach upon returning to his/her country.

Remarks: To improve the follow-up offered to the coach, the Federation will maintain contact with the scholarship holder and inform Olympic Solidarity of any particular results obtained in national, regional or international competitions, including the Olympic Games.
